SUBMISSION OF FORMS, NOMINATION AND ELECTION PERIODS

Nominations should be submitted by email attachment to the Returning Officer, Ian Walker, at parsa.elections@anu.edu.au. Nominations will be accepted from 9am on Monday, July 17 until noon on Thursday, August 3. The 2017 General Election will be held online from 9am on Monday, August 14, to 5pm on Friday, August 18.

CANDIDATE PROFILE STATEMENT

During the period that nominations are open, candidates are encouraged to send to the Returning Officer (parsa.elections@anu.edu.au) their photograph and a personal statement (250-word maximum) in support of their nomination. The Candidate Profile statement must be submitted in writing, but may also be provided as an audio or video statement; these will be included on the Election section of the PARSA website. A full transcript of the audio or video statement must be submitted, and should be the same as the Candidate Profile.

NEW POSITION - POSTGRADUATE STUDENT MEMBER OF UNIVERSITY COUNCIL

Prior to 2017, the PARSA President had automatically taken on the role as Postgraduate Council Member. However, following the outcome of the [Walker Review](#), the [ANU's response](#) to that Review, and the passage of constitutional changes at a PARSA General Meeting in November 2016, the positions of President and Postgraduate Student Member of University Council have been separated.

The President or any other representative of PARSA can still serve as the Postgraduate Student Member of Council, but must be separately elected to this position. Equally, a student does not need to be elected to a PARSA position to be elected as the Council Member.
